

Relaxation of the restriction on duplication to enhance support for young researchers

<Current situation>

The purpose of "Early Career Scientists" is to give inexperienced researchers opportunities to obtain research funding and to help them make a good start as researchers. Relaxing the restriction on duplicate applications is extremely important from the perspective of supporting young researchers.

To increase the opportunities for young researchers to take on new challenges. To improve their chances of advancement,

apply for and receive both the "Early Career Scientists (2nd)" and "Challenging Research (Pioneering)" grants in duplicate.

The program will continue to consider how to restrict duplicate applications for the "Early Career Scientists (1st)".

Points for revision

The "Review Section Table" which will be applied from the 2023 fiscal year has been revised.




Conducting joint screenings in multiple basic sections in Grant-in-Aid for Scientific Research (B)
